Situated on a 2,400 acre working deer and sheep high country station (ranch), the historic property lies on the edge of the Waipara River amongst manicured, mature gardens, with a backdrop of the Southern Alps. There is whale watching at the nearby coastal town of Kaikoura and options for trout and salmon fishing are innumerable. Hanmer Springs thermal pools and spa is a short drive away.

Andrew Harper has also given special recognition to the nearby Pegasus Bay as being 'the Most Hospitable Vineyard in the World', which lies in the heart of the Waipara wine region and is just 10 minutes from Claremont. The winery specialises in Pinot Noir and what Mr Harper describes 'an exceptional Sauvignon Blanc'.
